Dear Beth Zion Mishpocha (Family),

We wish you a blessed and wonderful new year, and thank you for your interest and support for Beth Zion over the years. This is a short update of some of what's been happening at BZ.

We have experienced some great sharing opportunities this year, along with expansion in a number of our existing programs, such as our *Out-to-Lunch* Bible discussion group in East Windsor, monthly musical ministry in local after-care facilities, our summer concert and immersion (*tevilah*) service at Ocean Grove, as well as special events with Paul Wilbur, Marty Goetz and others.

Our online presence continues to grow, with our YouTube music videos, and our weekly Beth Zion podcast messages*. Often we hear from people who found us online, and after visiting our Shabbat service, say they never heard anything like it before.

This year, we broke some new ground with a series of divine appointments with Holocaust survivors and *Stand With Us*.

While attending a *shivah* (a gathering after a Jewish funeral) for a Holocaust survivor, who had been a friend for many years, Marlene was approached by another survivor, who asked if she knew of anywhere she could speak. Marlene said she did, but would have to tell her later. Jeannie wondered why she had to wait. Marlene called her, and explained that we were Messianic Jews. She, like our other survivor friend, had no problem with that. She and Marlene then shared their personal testimonies.

After hearing of the miraculous story of her family's survival in Poland, she did speak at Beth Zion. The best part is that we have continued to grow in our friendship ever since. In fact, Rabbi Jan was so inspired by her story, that he wrote the song, Crystal Night, which is on his latest CD, in honor of her family. Another divine appointment began with some young people who were confused about Israel. At that time, Marlene wasn't sure how to effectively reach them. Two months later she received something in the mail from Stand With Us. They are a Jewish organization that teaches and equips young people with skills to effectively answer the many false claims that are being propagated about Israel on numerous college campuses. The Lord enabled us to connect them with the Messianic movement. One of their representatives spoke at the Messianic Rabbis' Conference, our congregation, and at Messiah 2019. The presentations were very powerful and productive. God seems to be opening new alliances in areas we have not seen before. Keep asking God for His divine appointments everyday, and expect to see God bring transformation and restoration in a world that is in great need of Messiah and His divine presence.

Please keep our building project in prayer, as the Lord is giving us great favor. Now, more than ever, your generous financial support is appreciated, as we continue to *press toward the goal* of the high calling of God in the Messiah Yeshua. \Leftrightarrow


